B-Tech Admissions 2025 - 26

Registration is open to eligible candidates for B-Tech admissions in the Academic Year 2025-26. Qualification and admission criteria will be based on the norms of the Govt. of Kerala and the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University (Kerala Technological University).

Eligibility:

• Candidates must be citizens of India

For Govt Quota

Candidates should qualify in the Engineering Entrance Exam, KEAM 2025, conducted by Commissioner of Entrance Exams, Govt. of Kerala. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects and Chemistry as one of the optional subject with atleast 45% marks put together in the above subjects are eligible for admission. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/ SEBC and the candidates included in the PwD quota list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the minimum marks required for admission shall be 5% less than that prescribed for general category.

For Management Quota

Candidates should qualify in the Engineering Entrance Exam, KEAM 2025, conducted by Commissioner of Entrance Exams, Govt. of Kerala or JEE Mains. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects and Chemistry as one of the optional subject with atleast 45% marks put together in the above subjects are eligible for admission.

<u>For NRI Quota</u>

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects and Chemistry as one of the optional subject with at least 45% marks put together in the above subjects are eligible for admission. No need to qualify entrance examination (KEAM/JEE).

• Rounding off the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

<u>Age</u>

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31st December 2025. No relaxation of age will be allowed.
